

## Indicative Timeline for FMCS

Process Steps	Particular	Remarks	Timeline (in days)
1	Confirmation on IS Standard	- We will evaluate the product and suggest the best possible corresponding Indian Standards	2-3 days
2	Testing on Product Sample along with equipment's setup for audit	- This step can be skipped if the manufacturer is confident about the quality as per Indian Standard. - This step can be skipped if manufacturer has in-house lab and can prepare test reports in the required format.	30-45 days
3	Filling of BIS application & govt. fee	- Submission of applications along with required documents. - Payment of govt. fee. It should be paid directly by the applicant to BIS designated accounts	6-7 days
4	Factory audit by BIS officer	- BIS officer will visit the factory for 2-3 days for physical verification of factory set-up and Quality Control process - This includes following cost- Travelling, Logistics, Contingency fund, Diem Allowance etc.	30-45 days
5	Sample testing & handling fee	- BIS officer will randomly pick-up the samples of product during his/her visit. - The samples will be tested in BIS accredited lab and expanses will be borne by applicant.	30-45 days
6	Minimum annual license fee & Bank Guarantee	- Paying of annual license fee (it varies product to product) and bank guarantee of USD10000 - Issuance of certificate/license	10-15 days

**Note:**

-Above is the indicative timeline only, it may change depending on the actual case.

-In case of all India first license, additional timeline of 1 month can be considered.
