

## Indicative Timeline for Product Certification Scheme

Process Steps	Particular	Remarks	Timeline (in days)
1	Confirmation on IS Standard	- We will evaluate the product, fulfil the gap (if any) and suggest the best possible corresponding Indian Standards.	1-2 days
2	Testing on Product Sample along with equipment's setup for audit	-This step can be skipped if manufacturer has in-house lab and the manufacturer is confident about the testing and release of the test report as per Indian Standard.	20-25 days
3	Filling of BIS application & govt. fee	<ul> <li>Online Submission of applications along with required documents.</li> <li>Payment of govt. fee. It should be paid directly by the applicant to BIS designated accounts</li> </ul>	3-4 days
4	Factory audit by BIS officer	<ul> <li>The BIS officer will physically visit and verify the factory set-up and quality control process and the same can be completed within 2-3 days.</li> <li>While this process some of the below requirements and their cost should be bearded by the factory side.</li> <li>This includes- Travelling, Logistics, Contingency fund, Diem Allowance etc.</li> </ul>	15-18 days
5	Sample testing & handling fee	- BIS officer will randomly pick-up the samples of product during the visit and will ask the applicant to send the sealed sample at any of the BIS accredited lab.  - The testing expense will be borne by	15-25 days
6	Granting of license	the applicant.  License will be granted if the product satisfies all the testing requirements.	10-15days

- -Above is the indicative timeline only, it may change depending on the actual case.
- -In case of all India first license, additional timeline of 1 month can be considered.
